- **Placements are made by the C.S.E.**
- **Recommendations to programs are based on students' needs and are provided in the least restrictive environment.**

Resource Room

- **Resource room programs are for the purpose of supplementing the regular or special classroom instruction of students with disabilities.**
- **The resource room teacher serves as the student's case manager.**



Resource Room

- **Students attend the resource room for one period a day.**
- **The special education teacher works to develop skills and strategies to assist the student in specific deficit areas, while supporting the curriculum.**

Collaborative Classes

- **Students are placed in general education classes and receive additional support from a special education teacher and/or a teacher assistant.**
- **Support class is usually added.**



Special Classes

- **Special class programs are provided for students who require primary instruction in a smaller teacher to student ratio.**
- **The content, methodology or delivery of instruction addresses the unique needs of all students.**
- **Ensures student access to the general curriculum in order to meet the educational standards that apply to all students.**



Transitional Support Services

- **Provided to the general education classroom teacher(s).**
- **This consultation may be provided by a special education teacher or related service provider.**
